MINUTES May 4, 2019

The regular rescheduled meeting of the Round Valley Tribal Council was called to order by President James Russ on May 4, 2019 in the Buffalo Room within the Tribal Administrative Building located on the Round Valley Indian Reservation.

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- Indian Education – we found out that the Tribe is eligible to apply and the Council approved for Julia Russ to attend a meeting in Sacramento to get the information. They are anticipating that Round Valley will apply and this will be for five year cycle. They have a bar graph that have every school district in the state listed and it ranges from 0 - 100%, from review of this graph Round Valley is almost in the red. Hoopa has a good program and the Council would like to go and look at their program. Also, at least two community meetings need to be held to see what the members would like to see in this program.

Discussion followed and it was asked what the Council did not reapply for this grant as education if very important; etc. President Russ also added that they met with the School Board and he will give a report to the community on the outcome of this meeting.

NOTE: A meeting is scheduled for May 13^{th} at 6:00 p.m. 1) Report – meeting with the School Board and 2) Community input on the Indian Education grant

Ms. Cordova asked Mrs. Stillwell if she could get the students to come to this meeting as the Council would like to hear what they want.

Round Valley Municipal Advisory Committee – This is a committee that was formed by the 3rd District Supervisor John Haschak and they had a meeting here. Mr. Russ and Mr. Rabano Jr., attended this meeting. Some of our issues are not the same as theirs – zoning for instance (under feds), although we are concerned about public safety and public health and of seeing this as a way to educate them about our Tribal Police (they are the first responders as it takes MCSO 45 minutes to get in the valley); if the Council received any applications for the Chief of Police position; the Council was informed that we are going to get a resident deputy; etc.
